

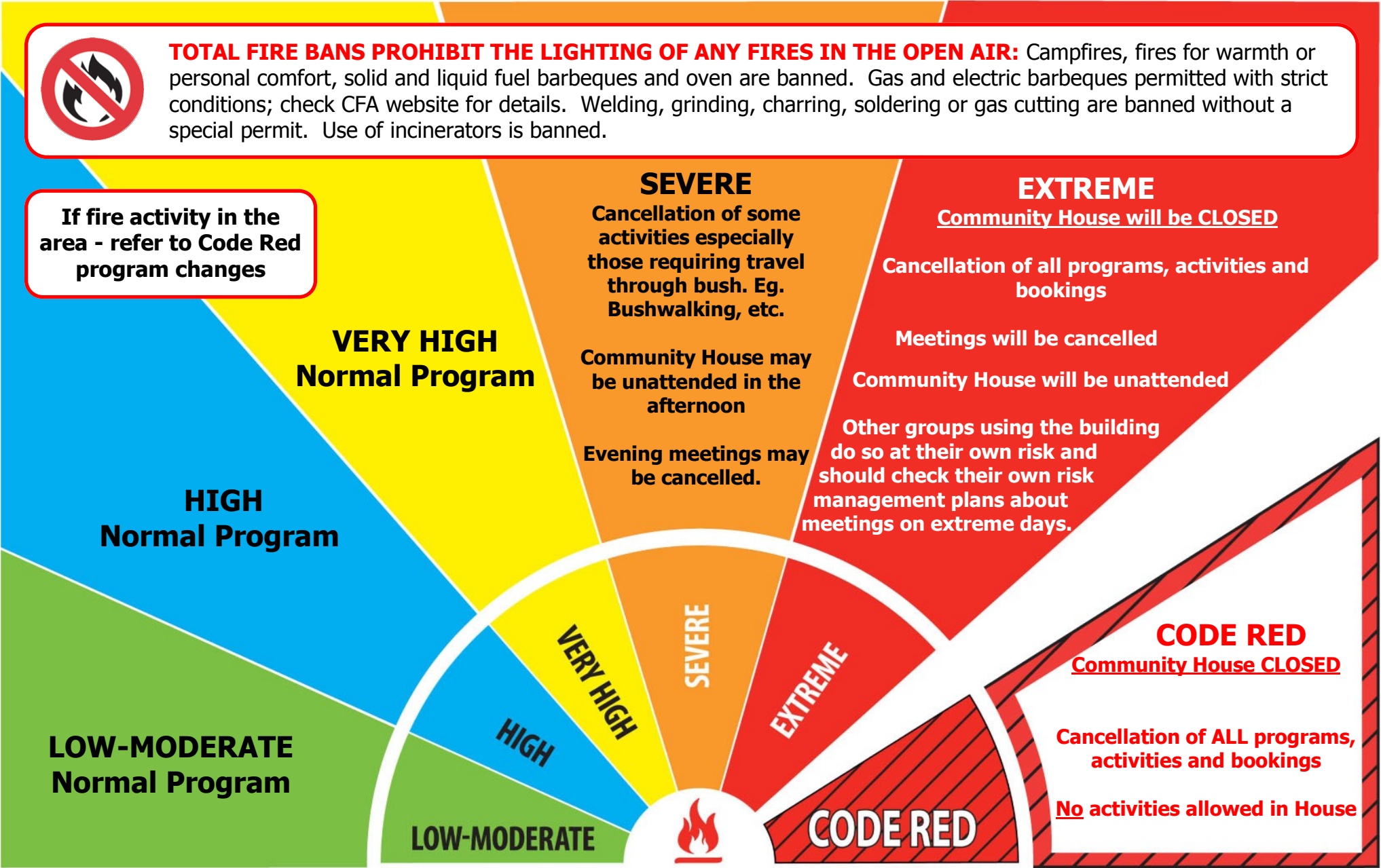
Gellibrand Community House-Program changes due to Fire Danger Rating

TOTAL FIRE BANS PROHIBIT THE LIGHTING OF ANY FIRES IN THE OPEN AIR: Campfires, fires for warmth or personal comfort, solid and liquid fuel barbeques and oven are banned. Gas and electric barbeques permitted with strict conditions; check CFA website for details. Welding, grinding, charring, soldering or gas cutting are banned without a special permit. Use of incinerators is banned.

Gellibrand Community House—Coordinator duties for fire season

1. Every day - check the Fire Danger Rating for the next three days upon arrival www.cfa.vic.gov.au
2. Refer to actions listed below for the day's rating
3. Check the actions required for the following three days - make necessary phone calls, etc. to inform of closures/cancellation of programs, activities and bookings

If there is a fire in the area, relocate, taking data and items agreed upon by Committee of Management.

Lead up activities for change of program

- Notify CoM Chair of changes
- Notify community affected by closures, i.e. participants

Lead up activities for a day of closure

- Record a phone message informing of day of closure
- Notify CoM Chair of changes
- Cancel meetings
- Notify community affected by closures
- Notify DHS (5226 4692) and COS (5272 9400)

LOW-MODERATE

Have CFA website open on computer - check periodically throughout the day.

HIGH
Have CFA website open on computer - check periodically throughout the day.

VERY HIGH
Have CFA website open on computer - check regularly throughout the day, especially in the afternoon.

SEVERE
Check CFA website hourly.
Back up data on external hard drive and have data and items ready to relocate.
Cancel activities which include travel or are outdoors.
Make sure you have adequate water and keep cool.
Finish your working day mid afternoon.

EXTREME
House will be **CLOSED**
Check CFA website hourly.
External hard drive and data and items to be relocated.
Cancellation of all activities & meetings.
If possible, work from another location.
Make sure you have adequate water and keep cool.

CODE RED
Community House CLOSED
Do not go to work!
Cancellation of ALL programs, activities and bookings
No activities allowed in Community House
